Variety and types of Homework:

NHCS we set a variety of types of homework depending on the age and ability of the pupils. The list below is not exhaustive but is representative

of types of homework that have been set in the past.

- Reading
- Learning spellings, multiplication tables, Mental Arithmetic tasks
- Completion of class work or tasks begun in school
- Research on a familiar or new topic
- Revision for a test.
- A piece of Maths, Science, or English work

Other work agreed between parents and the school.

A timetable giving specific detail on the variety and types of homework and the days on which homework will be set is agreed by staff and sent out to parents at the beginning of the educational year. The current timetable is attached to the school policy.
